

HJKYFCA Pee-Wee Division Guidelines for 2010

- 1 All present HJKYFCA rules and regulations will apply in Peewee games. **Focus will be on Fun, Education, and Discipline.**

- 2 Pee-Wee games will be played before freshman games. The game will consist of fifteen-minute quarters. There will be a ten-minute halftime. **Games will start at 10:30 am and will be concluded at 12:15pm**, whether there is time remaining on the clock or not. PeeWee weigh-ins will be @10:00, and Game day announcements to follow directly after.

- 3 The weight limit for Peewee players is ninety pounds maximum. Weigh-ins are mandatory before every game.

- 4 Referees will be made up of someone that is not a Peewee coach or parent, from each organization. It is mandatory to use a coach from the Freshman, JV or Varsity team. This is to ensure safe play and to educate the kids at this level.

- 5 There will be a coin toss prior to the game to determine first possession. Visitors call the toss.

- 6 All players should learn as many offensive and defensive positions as possible. These are learning years for these players. The coach decides playing time, but **must try to give equal playing time to all players.** **There are No losers in this division!!**

- 7 **No more than 2 coaches per team are allowed on the field at any time.** After teams break the huddle, coaches must move back from the line of scrimmage fifteen yards and be positioned outside the ends. **Coaches on the field cannot give instruction to their team after the QB starts his cadence.** Sideline coaches must remain between the twenty-yard lines.

- 8 Any on-field coach who moves or attempts to move his player either verbally, physically, or by use of signals **after the QB starts his cadence** will be cautioned that this is not going to be allowed.

9 Home team provides chains, down markers, and **shirts or vests** for referees

10 **Both head coaches must meet with the Referees and Commissioners before the game** and before the second half begins, with the exception of the Commissioners to discuss what they expect from each other.

11 **All Peewee coaches must sign this rule list so that all coaches know the rules and understand the reason for this division.**

12 The amount of time allowed in the huddle will be thirty seconds. The referee should be made aware of this rule and asked to aid in maintaining the flow of the game.

13 There will be two kick-offs per game; one to start the game and the other to start the second half. Kickoffs will be from the 40-yard line. If a kickoff is recovered by the kicking team the play is over and the receiving team will take over possession where the ball was recovered.
All other occasions where a kick off would normally take place, the offensive team will start with the ball on their own 30 yard line.

14 Punting; the team in possession of the ball on the fourth down will have **two options:**

- 1 Run a play and attempt to pick up the necessary yardage.
- 2 Elect a punt - the team in possession of the ball advances the ball fifteen yards in the opposing teams direction. This option is not available if the team on offense has possession inside the opponent's thirty-yard line. When this applies, option 1 must be chosen.

15 If a safety is scored, the ball will be returned to the team scoring the safety on that team's thirty-yard line. Intentional safety will not be rewarded.

17 Required minimum football size is equal to the Baden F-50.

18 Defense (see attachment)- NO Blitzing, OR STUNTING, you are allowed to rush no more than 6 defensive players. Defensive linemen may not line up any closer than “nose up” on the offensive guard. No defensive player may rush the “A” gaps (the gaps to either side of the center) without making contact with the guard first. Only 6 players are allowed in the Defensive Box. The defensive box is 5 yards off the ball and 5 yards off of each tight end (or where the TE would be). All “rushing” defensive players must line up on the line of scrimmage. Any non rushing player must be off the line. Minimum of 3 defensive players must be 5 yards off of the ball until the ball is snapped. This includes goal line and extra point attempts. **The only defense allowed at this level, is the 6-3 defense see attachment.**

19 **Offense- since we encourage the opposing coaches to allow the center to QB exchange to happen. There will be no QB sneaks, the QB can run the ball, but outside of the tackles only. Also any running back who carries the ball between the guards, must be lined up at least 3 yards behind the line of scrimmage.**

20. When there is a muffed exchange between the center and the QB, the play will be blown dead as if it never happened, down and distance will remain the same. Must run the play from the line without huddling up. NEITHER SIDE CAN MAKE ANY ADJUSTMENTS TO THE FORMATION, OR CAN MOVE ANY PLAYERS.

21. **Before the start of each game the Head Coaches will exchange a list of “A” Players. At no time will these players be allowed on the field with the “B” players with out first obtaining permission from the opposing Head Coach. When “A” Players must be on the field with “B” Players. (due to roster size) they should be the marginal “A” Players. Whenever “A” Players must be on the field with “B” players they should play on the line on offense, and at safety or outside linebacker on defense.**
